The monthly Skyraiders meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM July 8, 2009 at the Butterworth Center in Moline, by President Rockne Brosman. There were 9 members present. There were no new members or visitors present.

The minutes of the last months meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was read and approved.

Old and new business:

1. The upcoming flying events were mentioned.
2. The August Skyraiders contest event was discussed. Since there will not be another meeting prior to this event, it was decided to hold a club board meeting before the event to iron out any remaining issues.
3. The subject of the possible Skyraiders flying field move to Newberry's was again discussed. There were no new pros or cons presented but opinions were expressed concerning the current ones. The main concern with the current flying field is the frequency of flooding and resultant maintenance and the main shortcoming of the Newberry field is looking into the sun while flying in the afternoon. There is no clear winner so everyone needs to express their views.
4. John Youngberg volunteered to do additional maintenance on the lawn mower and was given funds to make the required purchases.
5. The July 3 Milan Camden Park electric airplane demonstration was discussed with the main problem being crowd control. Suggestions for future improvement were presented. Because of schedule conflicts, several of the usual flyers were not able to attend. The club broke even on the Parkzone Citabria ready to fly airplane raffle. A nice donation to the Skyraiders was made by the Milan park board. The Skyraiders give special recognition to Mike Cobert for all the time and effort put into this event including setting up and flying from 2:00 until 8:00 PM.

There was no official show & tell but Mike Cobert and Les Schjelderup demonstrated the Parkzone Citabria, and the meeting adjourned a little after 8:00.

The Milan Fly was a mixed success. We had few fliers who participated, but all who did, had a good time, and the fireworks were spectacular as always.

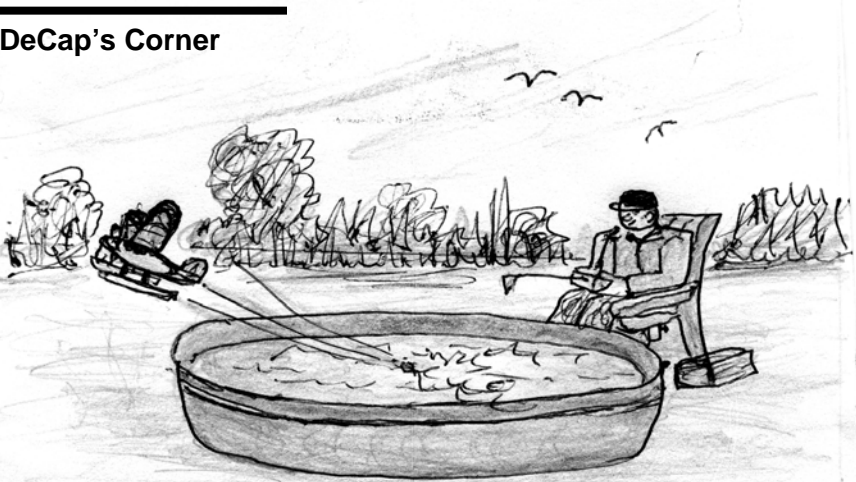
The Milan park board members again expressed their appreciation, by making a \$250 donation to our club, and said that they would like us to help them celebrate the Forth of July next year.
